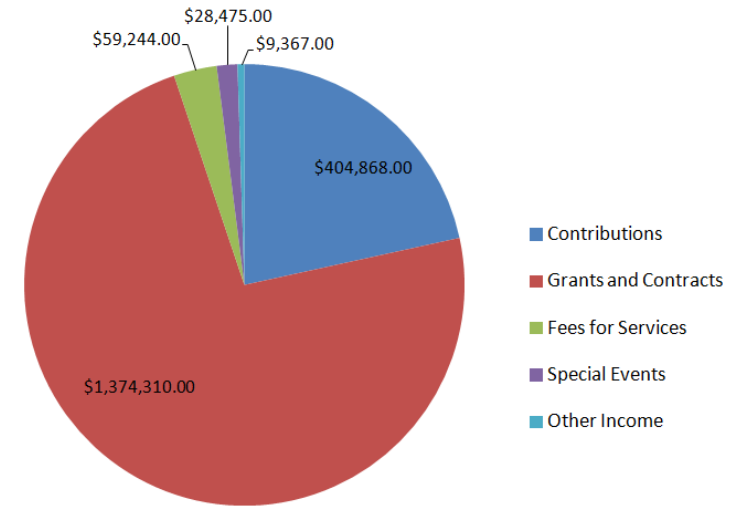
2014 Annual Report

JFS AT A GLANCE

As an agency in Washtenaw County that serves a diverse, international population, the mission of Jewish Family Services is to create solutions, promote dignity and inspire humanity.

- In 2014, JFS served **5,649** individual cases, providing over **9,208** units of service
- **511** cases received financial assistance, crisis/case management services, eviction prevention and referrals
- **157** immigrants received resettlement and post-resettlement assistance, **249** attended ESL programs
- **137** clients received international/legal services and **20** clients received Citizenship Education
- **346** people received employment and career services
- **625** older adults received services such as social services, caregiver consultations, and accompaniment to medical appointments through the PiCC program
- Transportation Services provided **4,600** round trips to medical and other appointments for **244** elderly and disabled individuals
- The Specialty Food Pantry served **2,347** unduplicated individuals
- Counseling Services were provided to **80** individuals
