



Flood causes JFS to close

There has been a damaging flood (related to the recent extreme cold) at the **JFS headquarters at 2245 S. State Street, Ann Arbor, 48104**. While no one has been injured, the damage is immense, affecting a significant portion of our building and workspaces, rendering much temporarily unusable.

Restoration professionals are currently working diligently to address the cleanup and repair process. However, until further notice, the State Street JFS offices will remain closed.

JFS Services will continue, without interruption, but will be temporarily offered remotely. Please see below for more detail regarding necessary in-person services such as Nourish Nutrition Services (eg., Food Pantry, Meals on Wheels) and JFS Transportation.

JFS Nourish Nutrition: Pantry and food delivery services, including pantry delivery and Meals on Wheels, will continue to operate. However, there may be limited hours of service during this time.
